SCUBA at Berkeley Safety Policy 2024-2025

Membership

- 1. Member must have completed the following prior to signing up for <u>any</u> dive trip:
 - a. Submitted all dive certification materials online
 - b. Passed safety exams (written & physical gear assembly)
- 2. In order to sign up for an <u>advanced</u> trip, members must have:
 - a. Prior experience in cold water diving
 - b. Advanced Open Water certification (PADI, SDI or equivalent)
 - c. Dived in the past 6 months
 - d. Minimum of 40 dives

Safety Exam

- 1. Must be completed once every academic year, including the following:
 - a. Written safety exam
 - b. Physical gear assembly of BCD on SCUBA tank
- 2. If a member fails the safety exam, he/she must attend a safety review lesson and retake the exam.
 - a. Failure is defined as:
 - i. Scoring less than 50%
 - ii. Answering ANY of the designated essential questions wrongly, regardless of the overall score.
 - b. Failure to pass the safety exam twice will require the member to hire a divemaster during dives.
- 3. Members <u>must</u> attend safety review meetings before dive trips, regardless of if they have already passed the safety exam.

Trip Planning

- 1. Group must meet before leaving for dive trip to create a plan. It must be approved by safety officer pre-departure and include the following:
 - a. Names and contact info of every group member
 - b. Planned dive sites and alternative options
 - c. Max depth and turnaround pressure for each site, depending on certification level of divers in group
 - d. Buddy pairs, safety liaisons
- 2. Divemasters are required if member has:
 - a. Not completed more than 20 dives
 - b. Not dived in the past 6 months
 - c. No experience in cold water
 - d. Failed safety exam more than once

By signing this document, I am hereby agreeing that I will abide by these policies for the safety of myself and other members. Failure to comply will result in a meeting with the board of SCUBA at Berkeley and potential revoking of membership.
